Lodges & Cabins In Custer State Park

Blue Bell Lodge

25453 SD Hwy 87

Amidst the towering ponderosa pines, Blue Bell Lodge is the perfect hideaway. Visitors can choose accommodations from newly remodeled rustic cabins to charming hand-crafted log cabins with fireplaces and open-beamed ceilings. All cabins are equipped with kitchenettes or kitchens. Fire grates are near every cabin and some cabins are available for year-round use.

Legion Lake Lodge

12967 US Hwy 16A

Located along Galena Creek, Legion Lake Lodge dates back to 1913 when the area was leased by the local American Legion Post, and thus, the basis for the lodge's name. A variety of newly renovated and comfortable, family-size cabins are nestled in the forest surrounding the lodge.

State Game Lodge

13389 US Hwy 16A

This gracious stone and wood lodge is set in a beautiful mountain valley, surrounded by a ponderosa pine forest. The State Game Lodge served as the "Summer White House" for President Calvin Coolidge in 1927. Built in 1920, it is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The lodge features historic and newly renovated lodge rooms, motel units, and pine-shaded cabins. Choose from housekeeping cabins with kitchens or kitchenettes, and sleeping cabins.

Creekside Lodge at the State Game Lodge

Opening in 2008, Creekside Lodge will offer 30 luxurious lodge rooms, a beautiful lobby and great room, two meeting rooms, and incredible views of the Black Hills!

Sylvan Lake Lodge

24572 US Hwy 87

Sylvan Lake holds the designation as Custer State Park's crown jewel. In 1921, this unique lake became part of the newly-created Custer State Park. In 1895, a Victorian-style hotel opened its doors on the shores of Sylvan Lake. After that original lakeshore resort burned down in 1935, Frank Lloyd Wright suggested the current location amidst a forest of pine and spruce trees. The lodge features beautifully renovated lodge rooms, a lobby, lounge, restaurant, and veranda that offers a breathtaking view of Harney Peak. Several rustic cabins in the area are nestled among the pine and spruce forest.

The park offers everything from hearty ranch-style breakfasts in a rustic lodge, box lunches perfect for picnics, to premier restaurants featuring standard favorites to wild game. There's a choice for all occasions.

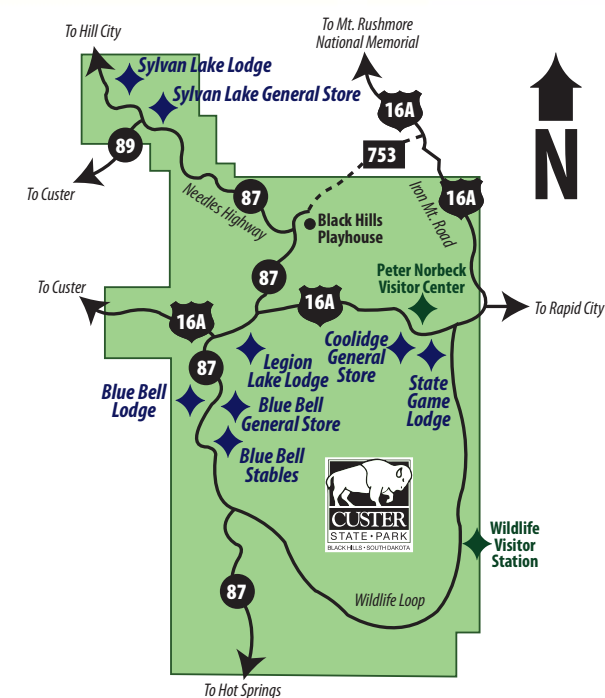

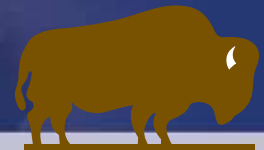

This old-fashioned hayride on a vehicle-drawn wagon takes you on back roads to a mountain meadow canyon for a chuck wagon feast. Sing-along country/folk music entertains everyone throughout the evening. Ask for exact departure time when making reservations. Late reservations and walk-ons will be accommodated on a "space available" basis until 5:00 p.m. Arrival at Blue Bell Lodge by 5:00 p.m. is required with departure at 5:30 p.m. Arrive back at the lodge around 8:00 p.m. Menu includes choice of an 8 oz. choice sirloin steak or a 1/3 lb. hamburger entrée with all the fixin's (vegetarian option available), including cowboy beans, cornbread and honey, potato salad, coleslaw, watermelon, cookies, chuck wagon coffee and lemonade. A souvenir cowboy hat and bandanna for each paying guest.
